Esmita is the Senior Lead Pharmacist at Imperial College London (NIHR Health Protection Research Unit for Healthcare Associated Infections and Antimicrobial Resistance). She is also a visiting Researcher at Haukeland University Hospital, Bergen Norway, and adjunct faculty at Amrita Institute of Medical Sciences, Kerala India. Esmita completed her Masters and PhD in London. Her doctoral thesis investigated antimicrobial stewardship across India, Norway, France, Burkina Faso and England.
