Dr Helga Gardarsdottir is an associate professor of Drug Regulatory Sciences at Utrecht University and one of the principal investigators at the WHO Collaborating Centre for Pharmaceutical Policy and Regulation in Utrecht. She was trained as a pharmacist at Uppsala University in Sweden and worked for two years at the International Pharmaceutical Federation (FIP) in The Hague following her graduation. Helga obtained her PhD in pharmacoepidemiology from Utrecht University in 2009 and worked until 2017 as a researcher at the department of Clinical Pharmacy at the University Medical Center Utrecht.

Her primary research interests include application and development of tools and approaches to evaluate the impact of regulatory decisions on public health, including safety of pharmacotherapy, as well as to provide insight into the processes of drug regulation. Within this scope her special focus is on bio-based therapies.
