

**Marion Bennie :**

Professor of Pharmacy and Pharmacoepidemiology, University of Strathclyde and Chief Pharmacist, Information Services Division, NHS National Services Scotland (NSS). Marion has lead the provisioning and curation of the Scottish Prescribing Information System (PIS) which captures all individual level primary care prescribing and dispensing events for the population of Scotland. The clinical focus of her research is infection, cardiovascular and cancer including large dataset evaluation to understand evolving patterns of medicines use in routine clinical practice and the development and impact of tailored clinical decision support tools/ health interventions. Current strategic leadership roles include; Associate Director, Health Data Research (HDR) UK Scotland; Chair, European Drug Utilisation Research Group (EuroDURG); member of European Medicines Agency Preferred Partner consortium for rapid pharmacovigilance studies; co-lead for the informatics work stream, Scottish HAI Prevention Institute (SHAIPi); lead for NHS Scotland Cancer Medicines Outcome Program. Marion has collaborative funded programmes in Brazil, Kenya and South Africa. Marion is a Fellow of the Royal Pharmaceutical Society, UK and Fellow of the Faculty of Public Health, Royal Colleges of Physicians, UK.
